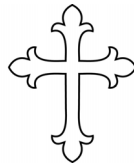

### **The Lord's Prayer**

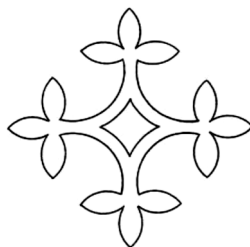
And now, as our savior Christ has taught us, we are bold to pray,
